Overview

Business Analysis focuses on the ability to analyze business needs and opportunities and provide solutions in order to deliver intended business outcomes. This hands-on workshop brings the participant through a case based scenario and a series of team exercises that allows them to work on a project that follows the IIBA Business Analysis process steps that have proven to enable the organization to achieve its strategic goals. Participants will also be exposed to tools and techniques needed to improve their effectiveness within the Business Analysis role. This scenario based workshop is lead by executive level practitioners with over 20 years of experience working as a Business Analyst with many best practices that they can share with the participants.



After completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Utilize planning tools and practices to plan the BA initiatives for a specific solution
- Gather, Document and Confirm Business Requirements
- Manage and communicate requirements
- Generate a business case that identifies a business need or opportunity and a solution that meets the need
- Prioritize, organize, and model requirements
- Assess and validate the solution and alternative solutions
