Managing the human issues is as important as the technical skills you will need for success. This course looks at the critical leadership skills necessary in today's resource constrained project environments. Utilizing basic techniques that have been proven in many industries, participants will gain insight into the skills that set a great project leader apart, and how actions, integrity, sharing and commitment can turn an ordinary project manager into an extraordinary project leader.

- Identify ways in which you can assist the project team in their roles
- Determine what team members look for in an effective project leader
- Foster collaboration by promoting cooperative goals and mutual trust
- Cultivate trusting relationships and in turn, motivate the team toward success
- Know how to use power and information in service of others and how to ensure that individuals feel empowered to take appropriate actions
- Understand the importance of integrity
- Identify the roadblocks to integrity and understand how to commit to the challenge
- Evaluate your ability to build self-confidence in individuals through establishing high expectations
- Plan and implement a reward system that benefits both the team and individual contributors
