

# Course Description

## Excellence in Project Management Leadership AMS127

14 Professional Development Units / On-line 12

### Overview

This course takes a deep and insightful look at the topic of leadership, the “art” side of program/project management, from two distinct yet integrated perspectives: leadership as applied to program/project oversight responsibilities and the ongoing personal development of a leader.

The course will emphasize the critical role that the “human relation” side of project management plays in the planning, execution and control of any size project effort. Utilizing insights and critical distinctions based on the facilitator’s vast and varied project management and executive leadership experience, participants will be brought face to face with questions about their own leadership effectiveness. This course requires “real” and substantive participation that will result in the participants being lead through a detailed look at the critical aspects of effective leadership, personal development, coaching-mentoring, managing in a chaotic project environment, pro-active and effective communication, and the distinctions of effective personal development as a leader.

### Learning Objectives

- Learn the critical elements of, and stressors on, leadership in a program-project environment
- Discuss the distinctions between leadership and management
- Learn the element to successful project team leadership
- Relationship development and ongoing management (influencing, conflict, creativity, communication and integrity)
- Work with the current models of emotional intelligence and its application with intuitive leadership principles
- Understand the dynamics and leadership elements of organizational change
- Utilizing a detailed leadership model, assess one’s own effectiveness as a project leader and create a personal development plan for future insight, impact and success

### Format

This course is highly interactive and adaptive to class interests and needs. A lecture/discussion approach is used and is accompanied by individual and team exercises with team reports. Project case scenarios will be used to highlight the best practices in the course.
