Course Overview

This course prepares participants for the Project Management Institute's Project Management Professional (PMP) exam, 2005 edition by examining knowledge gaps through the review of the five core process areas. Attendees will participate in a review of questions and scenarios directed at the PMBoK®'s nine knowledge areas likely to be encountered during the test. This course is also an excellent refresher for individuals who wish to review core project management principles.
