

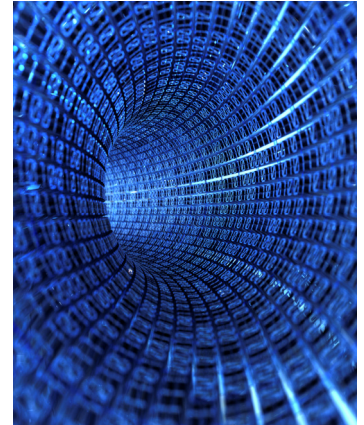
Course Description

Requirements Management: An In-Depth View AMS142

Overview

This course is for experienced Project Managers and Business Analysts who wish to acquaint themselves with all aspects of requirements, from concept through closeout. Participants will learn practices for requirements management, including proper selection of tools and techniques for specific types of projects. Stakeholder management and evaluation techniques to verify requirements early in the project life cycle will be key focal areas of this course.



Learning Objectives

- Understand the project management and requirements management life cycles
- Identify, categorize and assess stakeholders
- Create a communication plan
- Understand risk factors
- Understand the common requirements issues that lead to project challenges
- Understand traceability and global requirements mapping
- Identify multiple views and global requirements for requirements management
- Understand how to review documentation standards
- Select tools and techniques for specific types of projects
- Evaluate a policy for project needs and establish business criteria for change control
- Understand acceptance criteria and project test results

Format

The format of the course is highly interactive and how-to oriented. Discussion of concepts and principles is followed by exercises. The emphasis is on the practical application and adaptation of selected tools and processes.
