Overview

Time and cost management form the basic foundation of the discipline of project management. On time and within budget are two of the most frequently heard “battle cries” in the project management landscape. Based on the PMI®’s Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®) and current industry best practices, this course takes the participant through the development of project schedules, estimates and budgets, and the requisite planning elements for each. This course aims to develop a solid understanding of the “basics” and best practices of time and cost management.



Learning Objectives

- Understand the PMBOK® elements for time and cost management
- Understand and implement the best practices for schedule development
- Understand and implement the best practices for estimate development
- Understand the basic requirements and practices project control
- Understand the basic requirements and working of earned value management

The course is highly interactive and adaptive to class interests and needs. A lecture/discussion approach is used and is accompanied by individual and team exercises on participant projects.
