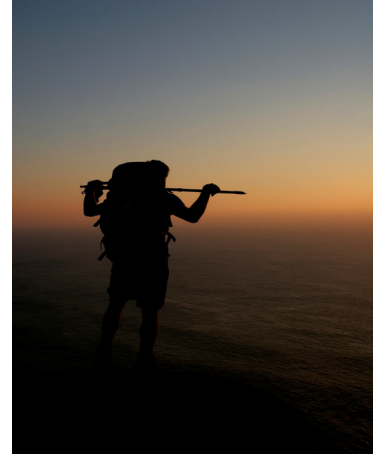


Course Description

ISO 14000 Environmental Management Systems (EMS) AMS317

Overview

This class will introduce participants to an innovative and cost effective approach based on ISO 14000. It provides a comprehensive strategy for conducting all phases of an EMS audit including assessment processes, commitment to prevention and continuous improvement. The techniques and concepts presented meet or exceed the ISO 14000 standards. This can be presented as a “high level” overview or can be expanded to a more rigorous experiential learning model. In addition to the class manual, participants will receive checklists to guide them through audits.



Learning Objectives

Upon completion of this workshop, participants will:

- Understand and apply ISO 14000 series audit standards
- Conform EMS assessment standards for internal, external and third party application
- Apply EMS auditor checklists and questionnaires for ISO 14000
- Know the key differences between quality systems, EMS and regulatory compliance auditing
- Develop and schedule a comprehensive audit plan for implementation
